We understand from the phone calls, emails and social media platforms that residents still have concerns with the proposed zoning law. With the number of people who have contacted us with questions, we want to be sure everyone who has public comment is provided the opportunity to be heard in the appropriate forum.

The proposed zoning law would be a village local law, so a Village Board public hearing is the appropriate place to accommodate public comment on the proposed zoning law & zoning map, not a Planning Board meeting.

A third public hearing for the proposed Zoning Law & Zoning Map will be scheduled for August 25th at Sage Pavilion, starting at 6:30 pm.

If you are unable to make the public hearing or would prefer to submit your comments ahead of time, we will be accepting written comments through the end of business on Tuesday, August 24th. As with any written comments for a public hearing, they will be read as part of the hearing record. Please include with your comments the article number, section number/name, subsection and page number for reference.
