For almost 2 years, the Zoning Law Update Committee has put in hours of hard work to focus on making the 2021 version reflective of the Town/Village Comprehensive Plan, the NYS Codes, and input from residents. The draft of the updated Zoning Law is on the village website for comment; don't hesitate to call the village office with questions. There will be a public hearing June 30th, 6:30 pm at the Sage Pavilion.

Thank you for your patience as Bonduelle assessed the reason and solution for the odor enveloping the area last week. A statement from the company was shared on the village Facebook page as soon as we received it.

Federal stimulus money which has been promised to municipalities will be distributed in two payments over a years' time. Lost revenues due to COVID can be replaced with these monies, and various infrastructure projects can be supported. No funds from this resource can be used to reduce property taxes or to pay debt. The rules and reimbursement requirements are lengthy, but I have begun the process for the village.

Road and sidewalk projects will take place in August, later than expected, due to the large number of area projects postponed for COVID.
