

**Public Hearing for
Sign Law Amendments and
Zoning Law update

Sign Law Amendment

Planning Board Chairperson Rene' Vurraro gave an overview of the amendment which included changes to zoning map, allowing internally lit signs in certain districts, and making sidewalk signs temporary.

There were no comments from those in attendance and no written comments were received.

A motion was made by Trustee VanEenwyk and seconded by Trustee Robinson to close the public hearing. The motion was carried by a unanimous vote.

She also asked for clarification for parking of recreational vehicles behind homes. Mrs. Tyson asked if low density residential and traditional residential is differentiated by lot size.

Trustee VanEenwyk discussed her opinions on Zoning Laws and reviewed a few changes that she discussed with Planning Board Chairperson Rene' Vurraro.

A motion was made by Trustee Donovan and seconded by Trustee Chimino to close the public hearing. The motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
